

Martin Research Notebook!

Most of the Martin Family information comes from a variety of places. In the early 1980's I started becoming interested in genealogy and at that time was able to acquire information from a couple of different locations. One of these was an old Martin family bible. At the time it was in the possession of my uncle Clee Martin. It had the vast majority of the Martin, Cranford, Phillips, Norton, and McKnight information in it. Additionally, I received from my parents some family data sheets done by other members of the family, exact origins unknown. These confirmed or duplicated the family bible information.

About five years ago my cousin, Cleta Stuart-Porterfield published a compilation of family stories. These were passed to her from her mother, grandmother, aunts, uncles, and great aunts and uncles. Most of these stories are published on these pages.

I started my own research in this area trying to confirm some assumptions made by Cleta and working on gathering more information about the participation of my family members in the Civil War. I also added an additional resource, Louie Clark book on Wolf Bayou and Healing Springs Township. Although not containing much Martin information, it is full of Kever, Norton, Cranford, and Phillips information.

I published the Martin Genealogy Search Page in 1996 as an attempt to start gathering more information on the Martin family. I also started using the USGenWeb query services for North Carolina, Arkansas, Tennessee, and Alabama. The results of these endeavors are outlined here.

03/25/97 - Received e-mail from Daniel LeVan, Alexander County, NC. He had a Martin Family Bible that had been donated to the Alexander County Genealogical Society and wanted to compare notes to see if we could link my names to the bible. After a phone conversation we determined that there was not a connection. Daniel was able to provide some assistance and confirm that William was the father of George Washington Martin. He also sent the death certificate for George W. as well as possible links to Solomon Martin (possible father of William) and Zadock Martin (possible father of Solomon).

04/10/97 - Received e-mail from Bill and Linda Gaines, descendants of Nelson Martin. Provided information on the Nelson Martin descendants and Kever ancestors.

05/7/97 - Received e-mail from Mark Orler, descendant of Gattis Martin. Provided information on descendants of Gattis Martin.

May 1997 - On a trip to Arkansas received additional research information done by my cousin Jo Ann Stuart-Bonner. It included additional Martin information as well as information on the Stuarts

June 1997 - Further research at the NW Region of the National Archives confirmed most of my previous information. I now have copies of the NC census records for William and George W. I also have possibilities for Civil War (G.W.) service and War of 1812 service (William) to do further research. My research attempts to confirm Solomon Martin as father of William provided a new twist. In researching Revolutionary War records and pensions I came across the pension application of Samuel Martin. I only have an abstract with limited information. Using the abstract information and further library research, I was able to compile the following facts about Samuel:

Samuel MARTIN, born in Ireland and came to PA sometime prior to the Revolutionary War. He then moved to Tyron County, NC, the part that became Lincoln County, where he enlisted. He applied for pension on May 13, 1833 and died in 1836 in Lincoln County, the part that is now Gaston County at the home of his son George Martin and wife Martha (listed as aged more than 69 in 1857). In 1854 the son George was the only surviving child of Samuel. In 1854 George was living at Dallas, Gaston County, NC aged more than 70 years. All other children having died prior to 1854.

Samuel enlisted on June 8, 1776, resigned in August 1777, and re-enlisted as a Captain and served until June 1780. He is listed on the Lincoln County Revolutionary War Pension rolls with the following information:

Samuel Martin, Rank: Capt, Sum Received: 750.00, Description of Service: NC Militia, Commencement of

Pension: March 4, 1831, age: 100.

Listed in the book *The King's Mountain Men* as fighting at the Battle of King's Mountain, from Gaston County (pages 86,257,303,478; 291-294)

He is shown in the 1790 North Carolina Census as living in the Morgan District, Lincoln County in a household of 6 males over 16 yrs, 4 males under 16, 5 females, and 1 slave.

A grandson William was born and raised in Mecklenburg County, NC. In 1855 he was a Methodist Episcopal preacher aged about 68. In 1856 he was in Spartanburg SC.

I believe there is strong evidence that this Samuel is the Grandfather of our William. I will continue to search for some definite links.

Made contact with another Samuel Martin researcher. Unfortunately, I had a computer crash shortly after receiving the information and lost his e-mail address. Hopefully, he will contact me again. He had detailed information about Samuel and William. The William named in the Revolutionary War Pension file is not our William, but he was a cousin. Our William was the grandson of Samuel. The mentioned William is the son of George, our William was the son of Thomas. He had more detailed information about his William line, but not much more about ours. He did give me some more leads on information in the South Carolina library. Will continue my search. Found a reference to Hugh Martin as the father of Samuel in his pension files. While doing research at the Family History Center in Salt Lake City, UT found a GED record of the Hugh Martin line, including Samuel. It had information back to John Martin born in Scotland in 1620.

Through an Internet search of Irish ancestors, found Martha Mason, another John Martin descendant. She put me in touch with Francie L. Lane in Yuma City, CA and provided biographical sketches of Alexander and Hugh Martin, along with information about Samuel that matched mine, except for the birth date. In the information provided, Samuel Martin's birth date was listed as 1745. In the pension files by his own admission Samuel was born in 1732, historical references sometimes indicate he was born in and married to Martha McCurdy in Ireland.

Hubert Martin's father, Robert Samuel C. Martin (115), died of typhoid fever in 1881 when he was only 26 years old. Samuel's father was George Washington Martin (118) (1825 - 1918), (probably known as "Wash") who lived in what is now Alexander County, but was formerly Iredell County.

The 1880 census for Alexander County, North Carolina shows "Sam" Martin, 22, his wife R.M.F. (Rebecca Melvina Florentine), 23 and "H" (our Hubert) 5/12 (5 months). In the adjoining household is his father, Washington Martin, 53 and wife "M" 46, sons 7, 12, 18 years old and a 25 year old female servant, R. Fox. It is noted that none in the household can write, but all can apparently read except one son and the servant. In Samuel's family, both he and Melvina can apparently read and write.

Civil War Service Record
12th Regiment of Alabama Infantry

L. T. (Trav) Cranford actually had two enlistment's in the 12th Alabama. The first started in March 12, 1862. He enlisted at Coosa County, Alabama to serve 3 years and was paid a bounty of \$50.00. It indicates he was born in Perry County, Alabama, in October of 1862 he was 22 years old, 5 feet 11 inches tall and his occupation was a farmer.

· Yorktown Siege - April - May 1862

He entered the Chimborazo Hospital No 3, Richmond, VA on April 17, 1862 and was transferred to the C.S.A. General Hospital, Farmville, VA on May 22, 1862.

· Williamsburg - May 5, 1862

· Seven Pines - May 31-June 1, 1862

· Gaines' Mill - June 21, 1862

· Malvern Hill - July 1, 1862

· South Mountain - September 14, 1862

· Antietam - September 14, 1862

He was discharged with a Certificate of Disability for Discharge on October 3, 1862. Discharge recorded viewed below. His condition was pulmonary hemorrhage following measles.

William Norton Sr. and his wife Elianor can be found in the 1776 census of Prince George, Maryland. At this census, William is 60 years of age (which would make him born about 1716) and Elianor is 38. Also found, is William Jr., a son from William Sr.'s first marriage, although I have not yet identified his first spouse. William and Elianor have quite a few children on this census, and two Negroe slaves. William Jr. is listed with his wife Mary, and their daughter Amelia. Several other Stonestreet families lived in Prince George during this census year, including another Elianor who was only 25, and I suspect was a cousin of Nellie's.

Samuel Martin was born in Ireland (1732) and came to PA sometime prior to the Revolutionary War. He then moved to Tyron County, NC, the part that became Lincoln County, where he enlisted. He applied for pension on May 13, 1833 and died in 1836 in Lincoln County, the part that is now Gaston County at the home of his son George Martin and wife Martha (listed as aged more than 69 in 1857). In 1854 the son George was the only surviving child of Samuel. IN 1854 George was living at Dalla, Gaston County, NC aged more than 70 years. All other children having died prior to 1854.

NOTE: A letter in his Revolutionary War Pension application indicates his father was Hugh Martin born in Ireland in 1700. Also indicates that Samuel was born in Huntendon County, New Jersey. But Samuel's sworn statement indicates he was born in Ireland.

Samuel was a 1st Lieutenant in William's Company, 2nd North Carolina Regiment of Militia of the Line.
